CARDBOARD, CARDBOARD, CARDBOARD!!!

Have you noticed the Trash Collector did not throw away the cardboard boxes you put on the curb?

Cardboard is recyclable. Cardboard put out as trash will not be thrown away.

Cardboard boxes used as a trash container is typically unacceptable.

If cardboard is not properly cut & broken down to approximately 24" x 24" and put near, or with the Green Recycle Bin, the Recycling Collector will not accept it either. Please remember, the Recycling Collector has to collect everyone else's recyclables. The Recycling Collector will not break down your cardboard boxes for you. If cardboard is found setout at the curb improperly the Recycling Collector will leave it at your setout with a sticker reminding you to break the cardboard down to size!

Residents are asked to please take the little extra necessary time to properly cut cardboard down to the proper size. Cutting cardboard down properly not only reduces the amount of garbage where throwing away, but also saves your tax dollars, because recyclable items are tipped at the landfill for free!
