NOTICE OF CHANGE IN BURRILLVILLE'S SOLID WASTE COLLECTION.

A competitive bid process for Refuse & Recycling collection was sought out during the month of April. Refuse & Recycling collection specifications were duly and legally advertised to all interested qualified contractors to collect solid waste in the Town of Burrillville.

At the regular meeting of the Burrillville Town Council on Wednesday, May 23rd, 2007 it was voted to award a new solid waste collection contract.

WASTE MANAGEMENT WILL NO LONGER BE COLLECTING YOUR SOLID WASTE AFTER JUNE 29TH, 2007.

COASTAL RECYCLING GROUP, INC. WILL BE COLLECTING ALL RESIDENTIAL REFUSE & RECYCLING EFFECTIVE MONDAY, JULY 2ND, 2007 THROUGH THURSDAY, JUNE 30TH, 2011.

Should you need to contact Coastal for collection information, appliance collection appointments or any other information relative to refuse & recycling, THE NEW PHONE NUMBER IS 1-800-266-3188. Please discard any phone numbers for Waste Management you may presently have as they will no longer be collecting your appliances after Monday, June 25th.

No change in route collection is anticipated and the same rules still apply for collection of materials. All residents are allowed to place up to five bags or barrels of trash along with one bulky furniture type item per week, per residence. Please do not exceed this limit! Please have your refuse & recyclables out to the curb no later than 6:00 A.M. on your collection day.

The Town of Burrillville appreciates your patience and anticipated cooperation during this transition period. Should you experience delays or have an emergency situation, please contact the Department of Public Works at 568-4440, extension 210.

Any scrap metal, electronic waste, tires or yard waste materials will not be collected if placed out with the refuse. These items may be brought to Whipple Avenue Compost Facility, as this is the current practice.

Please remember to properly recycle cardboard, cut 30" x 30". Improperly setout cardboard may not be collected for recycling and will not be thrown away. Please do not use cardboard boxes as trash containers.
