Refuse & Recycling Information

Weekly Curbside Pickup:

Residents are allowed up to four bags or barrels of trash and **ONE** large, bulky item such as chair, sofa, desk, or carpet. Carpet must be cut in 4' lengths, rolled and stacked neatly by the curb. Cardboard must be cut 3' x 3' and tied with string.

Disposal of items that are NOT accepted curbside:

Appliances/White Goods – washer, dryer, stove, refrigerator, dishwasher, dehumidifier & hot water heater – call **Coastal Recycling 1-800-266-3188** to schedule a pick-up. This service is free of charge.

Computer Ink Cartridges – DPW has free postage paid envelopes; drop in the mail or refill.

Construction/Demolition Debris – windows, shower doors, wood, bathtubs, sheet rock - bring to RIRRC or call a private waste hauler.

Hazardous Household Waste – chemicals, fertilizers, propane tanks, oil based paint, pool chemicals, gasoline, transmission fluid, etc. - Bring to Eco-Depot. Call **Rhode Island Resource Recovery @ 942-1430 ext. 241**. This service is free of charge.

Medical Syringes – ask your doctor or pharmacist, or bring to the Emergency Room at Landmark Medical Center in Woonsocket. Syringes must be in a sealed container.

Plastic Bags – tie in a knot and drop off at any ReStore bin, including Brigido's IGA.

Used Motor Oil, Oil Filters, Batteries & Anti-Freeze – Drop off at DPW facility Monday thru Friday 6:30 am to 3:00 pm (5 gallon limit for motor oil).

Items Accepted at The Whipple Ave. Compost Facility:

Christmas Trees – First two Wednesdays and Saturdays in January from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Trees must be cleaned of all ornaments and tinsel. **No plastic bags permitted.**

Electronics (E-Waste) – Air conditioners, TV's, computers, monitors, microwaves, keyboards, stereo equipment, mouse devices, modems.

Mattresses, Box-Springs & Futons

Metal (scrap) – bicycles, rims, lawnmowers (drain oil/gas), grills (cleaned), exercise equipment, pipes, metal cabinets, and other miscellaneous metals that will not fit in the blue bin.

Plastic (Rigid) - Children's toys, vacuums, hose reels, lawn furniture, etc.

Tires – must be off the rim. Limit of 4.

Yard Waste – brush must be 4" diameter or less & cut in 5' lengths or less. Place leaves in paper bags only.

Whipple Ave Compost Facility hours:

April thru May: Wednesdays & Saturdays from 9:00 AM TO 1:00 PM.

June thru August: Every Wednesday & the second & fourth Saturdays of the month from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM.

September thru November: Wednesdays & Saturdays from 9:00 AM TO 1:00 PM.

December thru March: Open by appointment only. Call the Department of Public Works at 568-4440 x 12.

Residents and businesses are reminded that recycling is mandatory in Burrillville.
