Toothbrush Packaging (cardboard backing)
Scented Oil (glass part)
Cardboard Box for Toothpaste
Cardboard Pill Boxes
Kleenex Box
Personal Hygiene Box
Liquid Hand Soap Bottle

NO –

Bottle Vaseline Jar
Deodorant Dispenser
Dental Floss Dispenser
Toothpaste Tubes
Lotion / Cream Tubes
Toothbrush
Combs & Brushes
Q-Tips
Facial Tissue
Bandages & Gauze
Plastic Pill Boxes
Prescription Drugs

MOST common bathroom items can be recycled. Please be sure all containers are empty of product. Plastic bottles and jars **MUST** have the following symbols on the bottom:



Plastics with the numbers 3-7 are **NOT** recyclable and must be thrown in the trash. **Aerosol cans are only recyclable if a magnet will stick**
